Training

Adair Training

Our trainers prepare your people for emergencies, travelling to your site (or using our purpose built training facilities) we are able to provide evacuation training and warden training, compliant to current Australian Standards, ensuring that your people are best prepared for any emergency.

Staff Training

- > **Staff Awareness** - Introduces building occupants to the emergency evacuation plan and outlines who the Emergency Control Organisation are, what their roles are and what is expected of a staff member or building occupant when an emergency occurs.
- > **Residential Awareness** - Introduces residents of a facility (Aged Care/High Rise Residential) of the evacuation plan, how they will be notified of an emergency and the best methods of evacuation.
- > **Shopfront Retailer** - Warden training in the basic principles of emergency evacuation from the facility and the use of available fire fighting equipment,

explanation of the evacuation diagram and roles of Exit and Retail Wardens.

Dealing with workplace fires

We prepare your people to use emergency equipment. Modules Include:

- > Introduction to the use of portable fire fighting equipment, including the classes of fire, fire triangle, different types of extinguishers and their application, fire hose reels and fire blankets. This includes practical training in extinguishers.
- > LETS - (See panel below).
- > Advanced Fire Fighting.
- > Fire Ground Training / Industrial.

Health Care / Child Care

Fire and Evacuation Training - Training for Staff Members/Wardens in Health Care and Child Care Facilities in the emergency evacuation plan, roles and responsibilities, methods of evacuation with various demographics and their associated challenges, also involves the theoretical training in use of fire extinguishers, when, where, how, and what type with a practical extinguisher demonstration/training element.



Laser Extinguisher Training System

LETS is a convenient and realistic application for all locations. We use a state of the art laser training system where live fire training at a client's site or a classroom situation is not feasible.

Easily transported and set up, this system can provide realistic simulation and provides feedback and analysis for the student.



Warden Training

Modules include:

- > **Initial training** - in the roles and responsibilities of all warden types and the various items of equipment within the facility that will assist/dictate the emergency response options, covers duties before, during and after an emergency, the assembly area and various basic human behaviour principles.
- > **Advanced theory/practical training** - in the emergency plan and procedures and will involve a site walk in order to locate and identify the various items of emergency equipment within the facility and discuss its purpose, involves practical instruction in the use of equipment.
- > **Scenario** - Advanced theory/practical instruction involving discussions about various types of incidents, possible emergency responses and the potential outcomes of using the particular responses, may involve tabletop only scenario or practical scenario utilising ECO and occupants.
- > **Sydney Safe** - A basic overview of the Sydney CBD Sub-Evacuation plan, what it is, how it activates and the possible responses for buildings based on their immediate distance from the incident location, covers the various Sydney Safe locations for the CBD and North Sydney CBD.

Human Behaviours

Modules include:

- > Advanced theory of human behaviours in emergencies including various case studies into specific emergencies and the resulting findings and conclusions.
- > **Scenario** - Theory and practical application of dealing with human behaviours including role play scenarios and table top discussions about how to deal with reactions to emergency

Difficulties During Evacuation

Modules include:

- > Introduction to various types of problems that may be faced during an emergency and when evacuating a facility, this includes various disabilities that may be encountered and basic solutions on how to work with them.
- > **PEEP's** - Advanced training in the use of Personal Emergency Evacuation Plans, includes considerations for who uses PEEPS, how do we compile them and who is involved, various options and solutions for occupants with disabilities
- > **Evac Chair** - Practical and theoretical training in the use of the evacuation chairs


Bomb Threat

Modules include:

- > Initial training in the roles and responsibilities of Wardens, staff and members of the Emergency Management Team when receiving bomb threats, finding unidentified articles within the workplace.
- > **Hazardous Materials** - Training for wardens, mail room and reception staff in guidelines and procedures relating to hazardous materials, white powder incidents and suspicious mail items. Includes identifying suspect.
- > **Scenario** - An insight into the various human behaviours exhibited during emergency situations and training in how to recognise some behaviours and deal with them in the best possible way.

Communication Officer

- > Theoretical and practical training in the use of the Emergency Warning Inter-communication System (EWIS) for the Communication Officer, Chief Warden and Deputy Chief Warden

Both courses complement the regular on-site training. Once enrolled your personnel can regularly access the courses online and refresh their knowledge.







Portfolio Manager
